ROAD TO EMMAUS

In today's gospel we find ourselves on the road to Emmaus. Two of Jesus' disciples are putting as much distance as they can between themselves and Jerusalem and the horrible reality of Jesus' death on the cross.

We can recognize ourselves in the disciples' response: when faced with a painful reality, we often turn our backs and take to the road. By distancing ourselves from the situation, we hope to avoid dealing with our feelings and with the situation itself. The wounds are so fresh that we dare not speak of our pain.

But Jesus appears alongside the disciples and draws them into conversation. Instead of avoiding talk about the reality of Jesus' death, the disciples find themselves led into a deeper discussion of his death and his entire life. The disciples discover, through reflection on Scripture and in breaking bread, that their pain and confusion have meaning. Their hearts are brought back to life and they are ready to face their life ahead.

When we gather for the eucharist, reflecting on Scripture and breaking bread together, we bring our wounded hearts with us, eager for the life-giving fire of the Word of God.
